Dear Parent/Carer,


As I am sure you will be aware, GCSE PE is assessed on both a practical and theory basis. With this in mind we are setting homework for your child which reflects the content of the course. Your child will not only be expected to complete a piece of theory work each week as part of their homework but they will also be expected to attend an extra-curricular club after school.

The purpose of doing this is so that your child is fully prepared for both the theory and practical exam.
