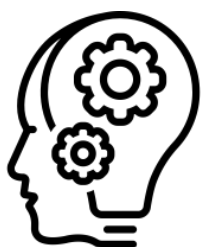


Topic: Paper One – Islam Beliefs and Teachings



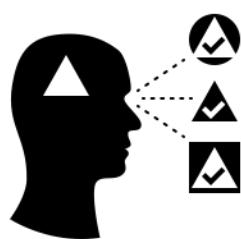
Specification: What is the Oneness of God in Islam? The focus is on the understanding of the monotheistic nature of Islam.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What are the Key Beliefs in Sunni Islam? To focus on the beliefs of one of the sections of Islam – the Sunni branch.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question. Compare and contrast.



Specification: What are the Key Beliefs in Shi'a Islam? To focus on the beliefs of one of the sections of Islam – the Shi'a branch.

Skills: Evaluation of statements – 12 mark question.



Specification: What is the Nature of God in Islam? To understand the nature of God and why these qualities are important to the faith.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: What is the Importance of Angels in the Islamic Faith? The focus is on the role of angels within Islam – particularly Jibril and Mika'il.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: Why is Predestination Important to Muslims? To understand what predestination is and how this will impact the life of a believer.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: End of Unit Assessment – Study of Religion: Islam – Beliefs and Teachings. The focus is on bringing all the knowledge of the topic together and applying it to GCSE questions.

Skills: Summative assessment point. GCSE style questions including 1, 2, 4, 5 and 12 marks.



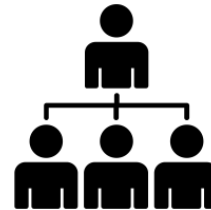
Specification: What Other Holy Books are Important in Islam? The focus is to understand the influential nature of other holy books on the Islamic faith.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What is so Special about the Qur'an? The focus is on the important nature of the Qur'an in Islam.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question. Compare and contrast.



Specification: Who is the Imamate in Shi'a Islam? The focus is on the understanding of the role of the Imamate in Shi'a Islam.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: Who are the Prophets in Islam? To understand what a prophet is in Islam – focusing on Adam, Ibrahim and Mohammad.

Skills: Evaluation of statements. 12 mark questions.



Specification: What do Muslims Believe about Life After Death? The focus is on the understanding of 'akhirah' and how the actions of a Muslim impact their life.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question. Compare and contrast.
