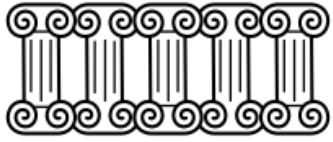


Topic: Paper One – Islam Practices



Specification: What Duties Should Muslims Carry Out? The focus is on looking at the Five Pillars of Islam for Sunni Muslims and The Ten Obligatory Acts for Shi'a Muslims.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What is Shahadah? The focus is looking at the first and arguably most important pillar of Islam – the declaration of faith and its significance to the life of a Muslim.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question. Compare and contrast.



Specification: What is Salah? The focus is on the importance of prayer in the daily lives of Muslims including the rituals and sequences.

Skills: Evaluation of statements – 12 mark question.



Specification: What is Sawm? The focus is on the idea of fasting that takes place during the period of Ramadan and what the significance of this is to the lives of believers.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: What is Almsgiving in Islam? The focus is on the helping of others within the Islamic faith through Zakah and Khums.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: End of Unit Assessment – Study of Religion: Islam – Practices. The focus is on bringing all the knowledge of the topic together and applying it to GCSE questions.

Skills: Summative assessment point. GCSE style questions including 1, 2, 4, 5 and 12 marks.



Specification: What is the Significance of the Festival of Ashura? The focus is on why the festival of Ashura is of importance to mostly Shi'a Muslims.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What Festivals are Celebrated in Islam? The focus is on why certain festivals are celebrated within the Muslim faith, including Eid-ul-Fitr after Ramadan.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question. Compare and contrast.



Specification: What is the Meaning of Jihad in Islam? The focus is on the struggle against evil within Islam, both personally and to defend Islam from threat.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What is the Importance of the Hajj Pilgrimage? The focus is on the annual pilgrimage to Mecca and its significance as a holy journey.

Skills: Evaluation of statements. 12 mark questions.
