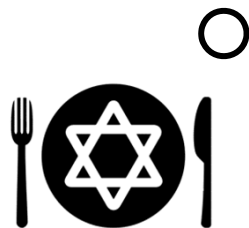
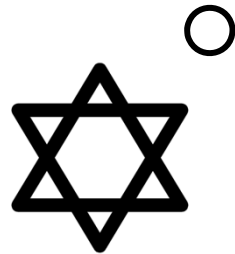
The Big Picture:

Famous Jews



Anne Frank is best known for the diary she wrote throughout the Second World War whilst hiding an attack with the rest of her Jewish family. Anne and her family were hiding from the Nazis who had strict anti-Jewish laws. Anne and her family managed to hide from the Nazis for two years before their hiding place was discovered in 1944 and they were sent to concentration camps. Unfortunately Anne died a month before the end of the Second World War. Her father published her diary in 1947.



Daniel Radcliffe is best known for playing Harry Potter in the screen adaptation of the book with the same name. Although he has declared himself as an atheist (someone who doesn't believe in God), Radcliffe has publicly spoken about his pride over his Jewish heritage.
