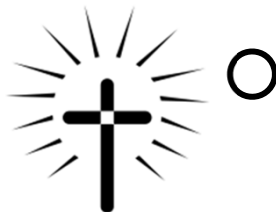
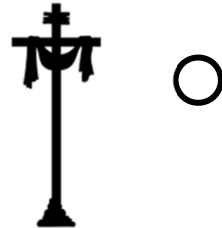
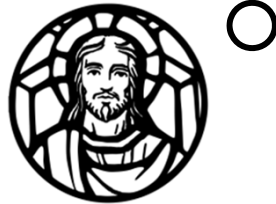
The Big Picture:
