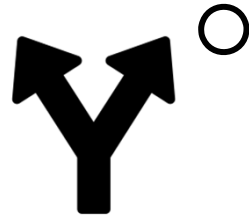
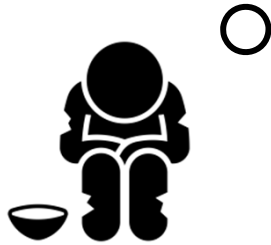
**The Big Picture:**
