

Dear Families,

As we embark on our second week away from the school building I just wanted to let you know what the next few weeks will look like.

This week we will continue setting work for the three sessions a day. Teachers will be available to look at what you do and give guidance. You kept them very busy last week, really well done on how much work you are managing to complete. Remember parents; health and sanity come first, so just do what you can, particularly if you have younger children at home too. Playing a game, working in the garden, reading a book are all just fine too!

Over the next couple of weeks you should receive a call from your form tutor or one of our teachers, just checking in with you and saying hi. We just want to know you are doing okay out there!
