
Topic – Paper One: Study of Religions - Christian Practices



Specification: What is Worship?
The focus is to look at the different types of worship that exists in Christianity – including private and communal.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What is the Significance of Prayer? The focus is to look at the importance of prayer and what might be used within prayer.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question.



Specification: What is the Meaning of the Sacraments? To know why baptism is important within Christianity, both infant and believer's.

Skills: Evaluation of statements – 12 mark question.



Specification: What is the Sacramental Nature of the Holy Communion? To know what the Holy Communion is and its symbolic importance to the Christian faith.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: What are the Differences Between Holy Communion Services? The focus is on how different denominations perform the Communion and why they choose to have it differently.

Skills: Skills: Evaluation of statements – 12 mark question.




Specification: What is a Pilgrimage? The focus is on practices associated with pilgrimage, and their importance to individuals and to the church – focusing on Lourdes and Iona.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: What is the Importance of Christmas to Christians? The focus is on the religious meaning of Christmas and how its celebration impacts individuals, church and wider society.

Skills: Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question.



Specification: Specification: End of Unit Assessment – Study of Religion: Christianity Practices. The focus is on bringing all the knowledge of the topic together and applying it to GCSE questions.

Skills: Skills: Summative assessment point. GCSE style questions including 1, 2, 4, 5 and 12 marks.



Specification: What is the Church's Response to World Poverty? The focus is on gaining an understanding of the work and rationale of one or more of the named agencies - CAFOD, Christian Aid, Tearfund.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.




Specification: How Does the Church Respond to Persecution? The focus is on an exploration of how far Christians who live in security are under obligation to support Christians.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question.



Specification: How Does the Church Work for Reconciliation? The focus is on specific ways that churches work for peace.

Skills: Recall of knowledge – 2 mark question.



Specification: Where is the Place for Mission and Evangelism? The focus is a critical exploration of mission and evangelism as a priority for Christians and church communities.

Skills: Development of knowledge. Explanation – 5 mark question with reference to scripture.



Specification: What is the Role of the Church in the Community? The focus is to know the role of food banks and street pastors within the community as well as the growth of the church.

Skills: Explanation – 4 mark question.



Specification: What is the Importance of Easter to Christians? The focus is on the religious meaning of Easter and how its celebration impacts individuals, church and wider society.

Skills: Skills: Evaluation of statements – 12 mark question.
