Making changes to improve


### Transparency


Being able to see through

Used to show how different colours relate:






- Primary colours

## **Primary Colours**

Colours that cannot be made from other colours


## Secondary Colours

Made by mixing two primary colours



## **Tertiary Colours**

Made by mixing one primary and one secondary colour

The placement and arrangement of the components that make up a graphic


## **Symmetrical Balance**

The graphics are even on each side



## **Asymmetrical Balance**

The graphics are not even on each side
