cartoon	Preparatory drawing using outlines prior to creating a final response
composition	Pleasing arrangement of something
collage	Collection of materials, usually papers, photos, material placed and pasted onto a surface to create an image
Still-life	Any type of artwork (drawing, painting, print, sculpture, photograph etc) that depicts either man-made, natural or both objects.

The English term, "still life," is derived from the Dutch equivalent "stilleven." Romance languages used the term, "dead nature" as in the French "nature morte."
