What do we mean by 'Employability'?

- **Employability** refers to your ability to gain and maintain employment (a job).
- It is about having a set of skills, knowledge, and personal qualities, which suggest that you would be successful in a chosen job role.
- You don't always need to have previous experience working in a certain job to gain employment. A lot of the time, an employer can judge your employability from the skills and qualities you have gained whilst taking part in school activities and extracurricular activities. So, all those after school clubs and hobbies you participate in, really help towards building your own employability!






