Dear Families,

We have been taking some steps to try to plan for, and minimise any impact of, the Corona Virus. We know this is a worrying time for all. Schools remain open as usual and will remain open until any changes in government advice.

We are making plans for all eventualities. So we are looking at how we would keep our young people working if schools were to close. We are also looking at ways to keep supporting you as families if the school site were not open. However at the moment it is lessons and revision as usual. We are following advice and not running certain trips and activities, details will follow next week if this affects your child.

We do intend running revision and Easter classes as normal AT THIS STAGE, but we will adjust plans as advice changes over time. Our aim is to minimise impact on year 11 first and foremost, given how close we are to their examinations.

Thank you too for your prompt responses about access to the internet and devices. We are putting together work packs for these families, which will be ready next week. We will give them out so you have them at home just in case we have to close at short notice.

I would urge you to keep up the good hygiene routines. We are promoting this in school at all times.
