Future Zoo: Blackpool Zoo trip - update

Thank you for your patience. We have now received final details about the Future Zoo trip.

Friday 17 June 2022	Please arrive at Shuttleworth College by 8am. The group will return to school by 3.15pm. <i>Transport is provided.</i>
Saturday 18 June 2022	Please arrive at Shuttleworth College by 8am. The group will return to school by 4pm. <i>Transport is provided. Please note that the school building will be closed so there will be no access to toilet facilities in school on this day.</i>
Lunch	Lunch is provided. Students may bring snacks and water. <i>Please notify us of any dietary requirements if you have not already done so.</i>
Clothing	Your child does not need to wear school uniform. Some clothing will be provided by Future U and Blackpool Zoo. Blackpool Zoo recommend: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Wellington boots, walking boots or sensible flat footwear• Clothes that can get dirty/damaged (no jeans)• Waterproof jacket and trousers (wet weather)• Sun cream, sun hat and clothes that cover the neck and shoulders (sunny weather) Much of the days' activities will be outdoors. Please check the weather forecast carefully for both days.

Free zoo tickets: You can claim up to four free zoo tickets on Saturday 18 June. More details will be provided about this by the zoo on Friday. If you are going to take up this offer, and plan to stay with your child at the zoo after Saturday's activities, please let us know by emailing Mrs Ackroyd on fackroyd@shuttleworth.lancs.sch.uk by Thursday 16 June. Your child may then leave the zoo with you in your own time. We will assume that your child will return with the group to Shuttleworth College on the provided coach unless you inform us otherwise.

Please note we will be using the Form 3A as consent for this visit. Please complete this if you have not already done so – you will be sent a link to the online form. Students must bring any medication they may need on the day. We will use existing photograph consent for your child if you have given your permission. If you do not wish your child's photograph to be taken you must send a letter to Mrs Kim Turner **before** the trip takes place.
