



Year 9 History – Unit 2: How did dictators gain power in the 20th Century?

Both Communism and Fascism used aspects of totalitarianism as part of their governments. In general, both used dictators, only allowed one political party, and denied many individual rights. Police terror was used for control and to get rid of any opposition. Controlling media sources (newspapers, television, radio etc.) with propaganda and limiting what was reported helped influence what people thought.
