

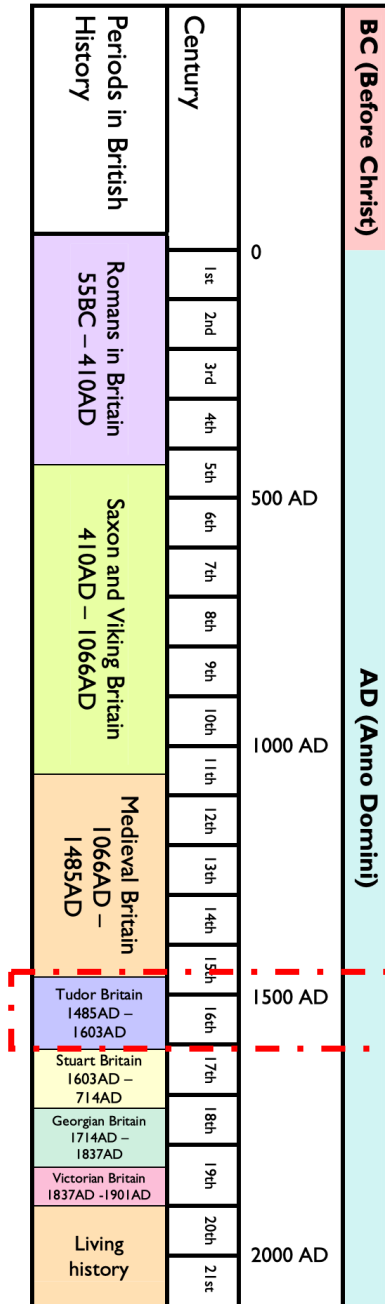
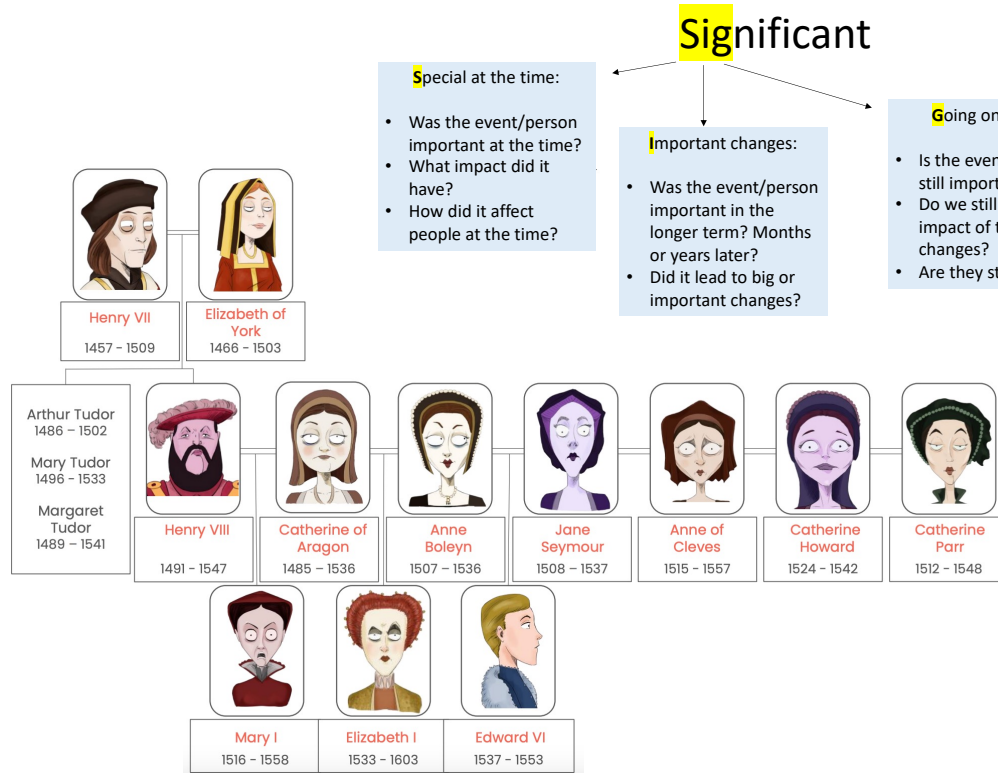

Annulled	ending a marriage
Catholic	also known as the Roman Catholic Church, headed by the Pope
Conflict	a serious disagreement or argument. Sometimes involving violence
Dynasty	when one family rules for a long time
Excommunicate	being expelled from the Catholic Church, a very serious punishment
Protestant	a type of Christianity that follows the principles of the Reformation
Secure	when something is safe or without threat
Succession	who becomes the next monarch / inherits the throne
