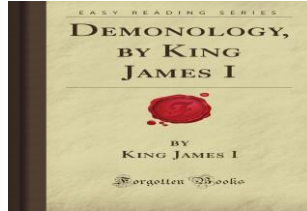


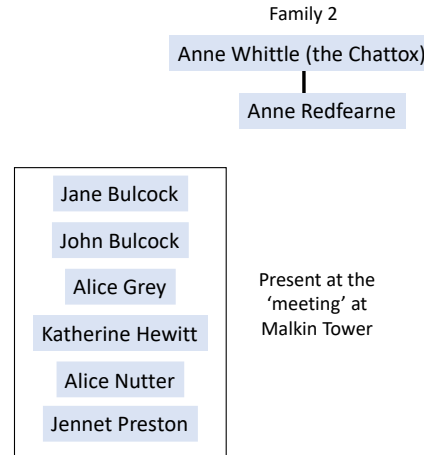
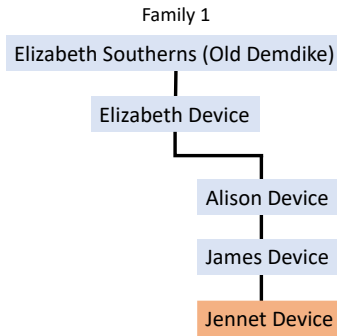

Keyword	Definition	Keyword	Definition
Accusation	when it is believed that someone has done something wrong or committed a crime	Superstition	strong belief in things that haven't been proven
Execution	when you are sentenced to die as a punishment	Suspicious	a feeling that something is wrong, or someone has behaved wrongly
Guilty	responsible for doing something wrong	Theory	an explanation for why something happened
Peddler	someone who travels around selling random items	Trial	when evidence is presented to decide if someone is innocent or guilty
Pillory	a wooden or metal frame used to publicly punish somebody
