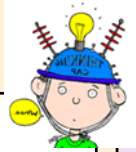


Learning Journey: Year 7 Twisted Tales (reading & writing)



Vocab

origins: the point or place where something begins

genre: a style of writing

moral: right or wrong behaviour

conventions: things you would expect to see in a style of writing

narrative arc: the different parts to a plot of a story

inference: identifying what quotations suggest

Big Idea: "Fairy tales to me are never happy, sweet stories. They're moral stories about overcoming the dark side and the bad side." – Joe Wright



What do I need to understand?

Origins of fairy tales, **conventions**, importance of morals how to **twist traditional fairy tales**, analysing a quotation, using **sentence structures & paragraphs** for effect

What are we learning?

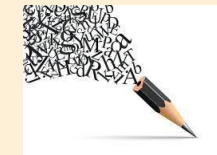
In this unit, you will **explore the fairy-tale genre**, building on the **reading and writing skills** you have developed throughout the year.
