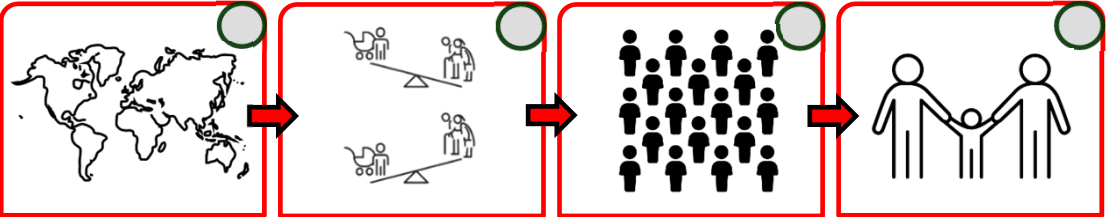

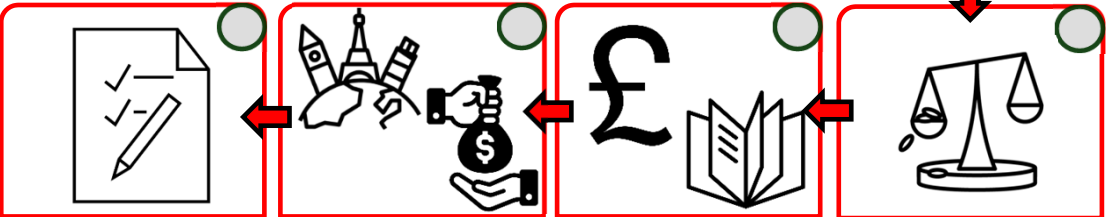
Big Question:
