Dear Parent/Carer,

As we approach the end of the examination period for our Year 11 students, we would like to take this opportunity to express our sincere thanks for your ongoing support. Your encouragement at home has played a vital role in helping students navigate what can be a demanding and important time.

We are now nearing the final full cohort examination on **Monday 15th June** (Physics), with a small number of students sitting **Spanish on Tuesday 16th June**. Once students have completed their final examination, they are free to leave school and are not required to return until the scheduled leavers' events, with details outlined below:

- Students are invited back into school at **1:00pm on Wednesday 24th June**, where they will have the opportunity to sign shirts and leavers' books with their peers.
- Students do not need to attend in full uniform but are welcome to do so for photos and to get their shirt signed.
- If they wish to donate their school tie, we would be very grateful to receive these.

The leavers' assembly will be followed by a buffet, allowing students and staff to celebrate together. Students will leave the school site by **3:00pm at the latest**.

On this day, students will also receive their year books and leavers' hoodies if they have purchased one.

Most students have now downloaded the **Education Results App** and have had their identification verified by me or Miss Southern. If your child has not yet done so, please encourage them to come and see us as soon as possible so this can be completed promptly.

Looking ahead, **Results Day** will take place on **Thursday 20th August**. Students are welcome to attend school with their families between **9:00am and 11:00am** to collect their results. If a student is unable to attend in person and wishes for someone else to collect their results on their behalf, we will need a **signed letter of permission from the student in advance**.

Once again, thank you for your support over the last five years. It has been a pleasure to work with your children, and we hope they are looking forward to celebrating the end of their secondary school journey at their Leavers' Assembly.
