Dear Families,

As you may be aware the NHS vaccination programme for coronavirus now extends to a second dose for 12-15 year olds. Students who had their first jab in October are now eligible for their second dose and these vaccinations will be taking place in school on Wednesday 2nd February. There will also be opportunity on this date for any students age 12-15 who haven't yet had their first vaccination to do so.

- This vaccination will only be available for children who are between 12-15 on the 2nd itself.
- Young people aged 16 and over can book their vaccinations online [here](#).
- There is currently no plan to vaccinate the under 12s.
- Vaccinations will only take place with children where prior consent has been given by parents/carers.

Consent forms for first and second vaccinations can be completed via this link <https://forms.office.com/r/kYgEFhixZ> . There is the option on the form to say you consent or you do not consent.

The vaccination programme is being managed and delivered solely by the NHS. Our function is purely that of providing a venue. Any queries or issues you may have regarding the vaccination of children cannot be answered by us in school. Unfortunately, we had very little notice of this so please note there is a very short turnaround for consent forms which will only be available via the link until Sunday 30th January; there will be no option to opt in after that time.
