Subject information for students and teachers

This advance information covers Component 3 only. There is no advance information for Component 1 or Component 2 which are NEA.

The following areas of content are suggested as key areas of focus for revision and final preparation, in relation to the Summer 2022 examinations.

The aim should still be to cover all specification content in teaching and learning.

Component 3

The extracts will focus on the following genres/styles within each area of study: Set works questions will focus on section B of the Badinerie and on the second verse and chorus of Africa.

Unprepared extracts will be in the following genres:

- Romantic music
- vocal ensembles
- film music
- pop

The extended response will be in Area of Study 3, Music for Film, and the dictation question will require candidates to notate pitch only.

Teachers and students may choose to focus on these areas but should not necessarily remove other genres and sections of the set works from their planning. These will support the students in their understanding of the elements of music, and the set works as a whole or in context, as well as prepare them more fully for future study.
