I am writing to you with information regarding the NHS vaccination programme for coronavirus for young people.

The NHS will be using schools as the venue for vaccinating 12-15 year olds. Further information about the programme is available in NHS guides <https://www.shuttleworthcollege.org/covid-19-vaccinations/>

Vaccinations will be taking place on site on Thursday 14th October.

- This vaccination will only be available for children who are between 12-15 on the 14th itself.
- Young people aged 16 and over can book their vaccinations online [here](#).
- There is currently no plan to vaccinate the under 12s.
- Vaccinations will only take place with children where prior consent has been given by parents/carers.

Consent forms can be completed via the school website. There is the option on the form to say you consent or you do not consent. Please follow the link <https://www.shuttleworthcollege.org/covid-19-vaccinations/> for the form.

The vaccination programme is being managed and delivered solely by the NHS. Our function is purely that of collating consent forms and providing a venue. Any queries or issues you may have regarding the vaccination of children cannot be answered by us in school. Please refer to help guides or the NHS website.

Consent forms will be available on our website until noon Monday 11th October. There will be no option to opt in after that time.
