Y7 are invited to a weekend residential trip at Newby Wiske Hall, PGL. This trip will run from Friday 21st May – Sun 23rd May 2027. The purpose of this personal development course is to promote self-confidence, self-esteem and teamwork, as well as to develop relationships with peers and form tutors. We feel the students will really benefit from this experience both personally.

There are limited places on this trip therefore it is on a first come, first served basis. Please click on this link [reply here](#) to register your child's interest. Please can this be registered by Friday 11th September. Once you have registered your interest the payment item will appear on your ParentPay account to enable you to pay the deposit of £45 which will need to be paid by Friday 18th September 2026.

A variety of adventure activities have been organised across the weekend, such as abseiling, climbing wall, orienteering, map reading, raft building, canoeing, archery and various other activities. There is also an aquapark and a 'quick jump' activity where you free fall and a giant fan supports you. All meals are provided by Newby Wiske Hall; however, students are welcome to bring snacks, drinks and sweets. There will be a parent/carers meeting, date to be arranged, which will allow you to ask questions and find out a bit more about the trip.

The cost of the trip is £175 per student. If your child wishes to go on the trip a non-refundable deposit of £45 must be paid via ParentPay before 18th September 2026. Further payments can be broken down to:

£65 by 31st October 2026

£65 by 20th November

If you wish to pay off more than this sooner, you are welcome to.

Instalment amounts received are transferred over to the tour operator and are non-refundable. If at any stage your child decides they no longer wish to attend the trip, amounts paid will not be refunded.

This trip will have a percentage of places reserved to be subsidised by the school. These will be to allow children to go whose family would otherwise not be able to afford for them to go. Alternatively, if you wish to split payments down to more manageable amounts and pay more regularly, or over a longer time period, this can also be arranged. As a school we expect all students to attend school regularly. This means having an attendance above 95%. We would like as many students as possible to attend the trip however we do have a number of students that would not currently meet the criteria above. If your child wishes to attend the trip, they will need to have an attendance above 95% for the remaining weeks in college up until the time of the trip. We will obviously factor in the issues a child might have if they have an ongoing medical condition.

We also have high expectations of students' behaviour both in and out of school. Should there be any concerning behaviour in the lead up to the trip it could result in withdrawal from the trip at school's discretion.

We will be using the medical consent form 3B as a basis for contact details and medical conditions. The link to the form will be sent out nearer the time,
