Residential Trips 2023/2024

I would like to let you know that we currently have spaces on some residential trips that are taking place during the next academic year.

Trip Information

EuroDisney 2023

Wednesday 29th November 2023 – Saturday 2nd December 2023 (4 days, 3 nights).
Price - £475 (Open to current Y8-9) We have limited spaces left on this trip.

Itinerary:

- Travel by Coach to Disneyland Paris
- 1 day Disneyland pass
- Bateaux Mouche River Cruise and viewing of various sites in Paris
- Eiffel Tower visit
- Return to College by coach. Return channel crossing by Eurotunnel or ferry to Calais
- Breakfast and evening meal is provided – students will need some money to buy lunch/snacks throughout the day

London - February - £400 approx TBC (Open to current Y8-9)

Itinerary

- Travel by train from Preston – London Euston. Returning to College.
- Accommodation in hotel or school group hostel depending on availability.
- Day 1 – Travel to London on the train, dinner & theatre visit.
- Day 2 - 'hop on- hop off' exploration of London, Thames cruise and dinner at restaurant. Including London Eye and Buckingham Palace?
- Day 3 – Oxford Street Shopping & return home.

Barcelona Sports Tour - May half term - £750 (Open to current Y7-9)

Itinerary:

- Coach travel. Including 2x night journeys.
- Accommodation in Hotel in Lloret de Mar
- Two day sports festival including two guest coaching sessions and tournament matches with British Schools
- Barcelona excursion (Nou Camp stadium visit and museum entry included)
- Water World water park entry
- Evening party
- Full board stay in the hotel; including buffet breakfast, packed lunch and evening dinner, water is included free with meals.

Madrid Spanish trip - July 2024 4days/3night - £650 approx. (Open to current Y7-9)

Itinerary:

- Travel by air to Madrid
- Tour of Bernebeu Stadium
- Sightseeing around Madrid
- Warner Brothers theme park entrance
- Students will be provided continental breakfast within the hotel each day and their evening meal at local restaurants. Students will need some money to buy lunch/snacks throughout the day.

There will also be a EuroDisney 2024 trip for students currently in Y7/8 and we will share details at a later date.

There are limited places on these trips therefore there on a first come, first served basis. Please click on this link <https://forms.office.com/e/d7NXx18U4G> to register your child's interest. Once you have registered their interest the payment item will appear on their ParentPay account to enable you to pay the deposit. The deposits are as follows;

EuroDisney 2023	£125
London 2024	£75
Barcelona Sports Tour 2024	£125
Madrid Spanish trip	£125

These trips will have a percentage of places reserved to be subsidised by the school. These will be to allow children to go whose family would otherwise not be able to afford for them to go. Alternatively, if you wish to split payments down to more manageable amounts and pay more regularly, or over a longer time period, this can also be arranged.
