

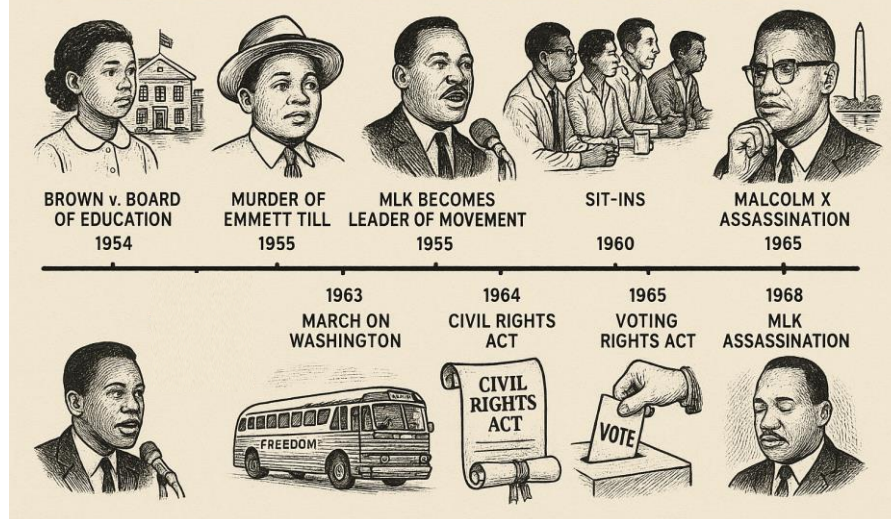

Keyword	Definition	Keyword	Definition
Bill	a term used mostly in America to describe their laws	Jim Crow Laws	Laws which separated black people from white people, based around the idea of 'separate but equal'
Boycott	when people decide to stop buying or using something to show they disagree with it	NAACP	National Association for the Advancement of Coloured People – a group who fought for civil rights
Civil Rights	the right to experience freedom and equality	Peaceful protest	where people show they are unhappy about something without the use of violence
Discrimination	treating someone different due to their skin colour, gender, age, etc.	Racial segregation	the separation of people into racial groups, eg. A school for white people and a separate school for black people
Freedom rides	people who fought for civil rights riding on buses into segregated states as a form of protest	Racial integration	Desegregation of the racial groups so that people of all races mix
Ku Klux Klan	a white supremacist group that targeted many Black Americans. It emerged in the south following the emancipation of the slaves.	Supreme Court	the highest court in each state of America
Legislation	a law or a set of laws that have been passed by the government	Supremacy	the belief one race is far superior/better than another race
Lynching	the public killing of an individual without a trial	Violent resistance	a method of protest that involves physical acts of violence
