Football Learning Journey: Year 10



Steps 7, 8 & 9: Assessment (game play)

Demonstration of skills in game situations (7 v 7; 11 v 11) to outwit opponents. Application of defensive and offensive tactics and rotating captains.



Step 6: Goalkeeping

Development of shot stopping - low (barrier), middle (catch) and high (jump and catch) flights of the ball.



Step 3: Wing play

Creating space individually and as a team to enable unopposed crossing on the move and when stationary.



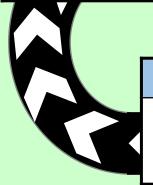
Step 4: Advanced shooting

Select and apply different skills and body parts to shoot on the move and first time. Unopposed and opposed.



Step 5: Defensive tactics (develop)

Tracking runs of an opponent via manmarking. Offside rule developed and applied to game situations.



Step 2: Advanced turning

Turning and starting attacks with one touch or no touch changes of direction. Application to conditioned game situations.



Step 1: Advanced passing (game situations)

Passing with tempo to make opponents work harder when not in possession of the ball.
