## New concepts and skills

- Infinitive verbs – an infinitive verb is the basic form of a verb, such as “to have”. It is the form we find in a dictionary. It does not tell us who does the action of the verb or the tense.
- Conjugated verbs – a conjugated verb is a verb that has changed and which does tell us who does the action of the verb and the tense, e.g. he sings, we play, I have.
- Possessive pronouns – mi (my), your (tu), su (his, her), nuestro (our), vuestro (your plural), su (their).
- Question words “qué” (what) and “quién” (who).
