We will be holding our Year 9 Parents' Evening on Thursday 22nd February when subject teachers will be available for consultation between 4pm and 8pm.

The school will continue to use our online system, 'School Cloud', which enables you to choose your own appointment times with teachers and receive an email confirming your appointments. The appointments will then be held on the School Cloud website as a video call so you do not need to attend school on the evening itself.
