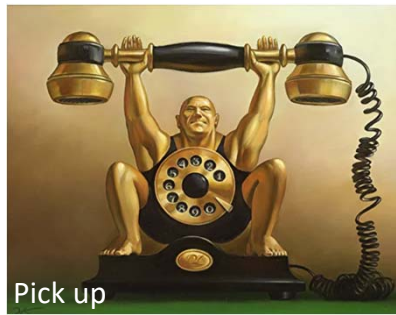

Unlike many ceramic artists, who focus either on function or form, Grafton combines the two to create highly imaginative yet functional art works. His specialises in what he calls "face jugs".

He uses sculptural techniques to create surreal sculptures that encourage the viewer to engage and interpret what they see.

A **visual metaphor** is an image that the viewer is meant to understand as a symbol for something else.



Surrealism was a cultural movement that developed in Europe in the aftermath of World War I in which artists depicted unnerving and /or illogical scenes.

surreal	having qualities of surrealism , bizarre
sculpture	a three-dimensional artwork
contemporary	something created in the present day
conceptual	relating to or based on mental concepts
ceramic	made from clay and permanently hardened with heat
slab building	a ceramic construction technique
