Y8 HT3 Melody Writing writing Big Idea: How are chords and melodies combined?

You have learnt what chords are and how they are constructed, how to improvise and perform other peoples songs. Now it is time to take the first steps to composing your own. During this unit you will learn to shape a melody using the notes of a chord and how to structure that into a simple AABA melody. You will start by creating a one bar ,one chord idea and adding a simple melodic idea to it and each lesson this will grow until you are creating a 4 bar idea.

What do I need to understand for this topic?

The big idea is to learn combine chords and melody. In order to do this you will need to remember how chords are constructed, pitch and rhythm notation.
