APPLY FOR SUPPORT

If you're experiencing financial difficulty or feel at risk of crisis, you can apply to the Crisis and Resilience Fund.

You must:

- Be aged 16 or over
- Live in Burnley (BB10, BB11 or BB12 postcode areas)
- Have savings under £1,000

You do not need to be receiving benefits to apply.

You will need:

- At least one month of recent bank statements (dated within the last two months) for all household accounts
- Statements must show your name, address and account number
